## Live Plants

Live plants from nursery will come as small plugs; cells are 5" deep x 2" wide at top or 4.5"deep x 2" Cone.

- Immediate care: remove plants from container as soon as possible and water thoroughly.
- Plant in the ground or a larger pot.
- Keep area around plants weed free, especially during the first growing season.

Watering is important during the first growing season. Make sure the plants do not

go dry for the first 3-6 weeks; water deeply to allow formation of deep drought and frost resistant roots. Once established, native plants can withstand extreme weather.
