TAC Rob Koppert gave his report and updated the Commission on the Datamaxx over-billing issue. Datamaxx recently had a change in the position of the person he was communicating with, and the new person was not aware of any problems. TAC Koppert will continue to discuss with Datamaxx a solution to the over-billing that is agreeable to each. He also informed the Commission that some dispatchers took an EMD recertification class in West Des Moines. He also informed the Commission that part time dispatcher Amanda Schuler tendered her resignation.

In Old Business, the Commission discussed the touchscreen dispatch computer issue. The Commission opted to check with the Cass County E-911 Commission which would be meeting later in the day to see if they would pay for the upgrade to the console, which would eliminate the current problems that exist, since the Commission has spent over \$10,000 on the backup console and has not been reimbursed by the E911 Commission.
