



RESOLUTION NO. 2016-002 Board of Supervisors, Cass County, Iowa

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT INDIGENT REMAINS DISPOSITION POLICY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Iowa Code sections 252.25 and 252.27, the Board of Supervisors desires to declare a policy concerning the provision of monetary assistance for the disposition of the remains of deceased indigent persons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Cass County, Iowa as follows:

- 1. Disposition assistance may be paid to a funeral home for the benefit of any deceased Cass County resident. Eligibility for benefits shall be determined using the same standards provided for in the General Assistance or Veteran Affairs Ordinance.
- 2. Application for assistance shall be made in writing on a form provided by the County and in the same manner as application for any other type of assistance with the General Assistance or Veteran Affairs Offices. The application shall be made as soon as possible after the date of death, but prior to arrangement with a funeral director. Application may be made by the funeral home director in the absence of any other responsible party.
- 3. A maximum of \$1,500.00 will be paid for a disposition, which includes the mandatory Medical Examiner certification fee.
- 4. The family or interested friends of the deceased are responsible for the purchase of a cemetery space or lot and interment. Cremains may be returned to the family or friends making application for disposition.
- 5. The applicant shall also sign an agreement to repay Cass County, Iowa, from any resources or benefits that belong to or are due to the deceased person. Examples of such assets or benefits are as follows:
 - a. Life insurance;
 - b. Real estate;
 - c. Personal property;
 - d. Social security, railroad or other benefits;
 - e. Contracts; and
 - f. Bank accounts, annuities, stocks, bonds and C.D.'s.
- 6. Said agreement shall be signed under penalty of perjury and any false or incomplete information provided by the family or friend will be dealt with accordingly.
