Kennon also handed out documents with director/dispatcher salary and wage comparisons received from surrounding counties. There was then a discussion about where Cass County stood as compared to other counties. Finally, the Board members talked about any possible salary/wage increase to include in the budget.

Kennon stated that he had completed a required week-long training in DM since the last meeting. There will also be a state-led continuing ed training for all available staff in Red Oak on Dec. 6th. Dispatchers have also been taking online training to fulfill their annual continuing ed requirements.

Old Business: Mike Kennon reported that the City-County MOU for Public Safety Communications was approved by both Atlantic and Cass County and had been submitted with the Sec. of State.

Kennon stated that FMLA paperwork had been received by the Cass Co. Auditors office. The Board will be kept updated if anything changes in regards to this matter.
