Tentative Itinerary

Day 1: The trip begins for some at 7:00 am at Target parking lot in Des Moines (11148 Plum Dr, Urbandale, IA 50322). We will pick up the rest of our group at 8:00 am at the Lowe's parking lot in Ames (120 Airport Rd, Ames, IA 50010). This is mainly a travel day. We will stop for lunch in Vandais Heights, MN. We will arrive at the world famous Sax Zim Bog in the late afternoon, where we will go owling. We will check into the Pineview Inn in Virginia and dinner will be on your own.

Day 2: 6:00 am we load the bus. With local guide and expert Erik Bruhnke on board, we'll be spending time at the Sax-Zim Bog in search of the amazing Great Gray Owl as well as other incredible raptors such as Northern Hawk Owl, Snowy Owl, Boreal Owl, Northern Goshawk, Rough-legged Hawk and more!

The "Bog" should additionally serve up dandies such as Pine Grosbeak, Evening Grosbeak, White-winged and Red Crossbills, Gray Jay, Common and maybe Hoary Redpolls, American Three-toed and Black-backed Woodpeckers, Boreal Chickadees, Roughed and Sharp-tailed Grouse, Black-billed Magpie, and Northern Shrike, to name a few. Amazing mammalian life of the North Woods that we could see includes critters like Porcupine, Moose, Gray Wolf, Lynx, Pine Martin, Fisher, Mink, and Snowshoe Hare.

We will lunch at a quaint café at the bog, check out the new visitor's center and snowshoe a bit. We will be staying in Virginia again tonight. Dinner on your own.

Day 3: 8:00 am we load the bus. Today we will be enjoying the charming lakefront town of Two Harbors for some scenic birding. It can be a wonderful place to see Bohemian Waxwings and both crossbills. We'll hit up Split Rock Lighthouse and Gooseberry Falls State Park to see the frozen falls, nature center and who knows what birds on Lake Superior. Possible sightings include Harlequin Duck, 3 species of loons, Long-tailed Duck, 3 species of scoter and numerous species of gulls. With birds and the lake, the sky is the limit! We will have lunch at the Vanilla Bean Cafe in Two Harbors.

Finally we'll be spending the afternoon in Duluth's beautiful Canal Park to soak up some culture and birds. There will be an option to do some birding around Duluth or visit the Great Lakes Aquarium for an afternoon. We will check into the Inn on Lake Superior and dinner and exploring will be on your own.

Day 4: 9:00 am we load the bus and head for home, but not before a fun stop! We will check out the Audubon Center of the North Woods to get lunch, a tour, bird and explore. Then it's time to head for home.
