We wish to make your special day a complete and a happy one while at the same time protecting this old stone home. The following policies will help in this matter.

Oral tours are given daily by guides and we will continue to do this while respecting your space during your garden wedding ceremonies and expect you to respect our space also.

There are no facilities in the house for the bride and her party to dress for the wedding. The bride may use the house to process to the garden for the ceremony. While in the house no furniture or other articles should be moved.

An electrical cord may be run from the house to the garden site. Please contact the caretaker for this and other special requests.

Access to the house is with guided tours only. Arrangements can be made ahead of time so that a suitable number of guides are available if your guests desire a tour at the usual fee.

If you would like, a very short welcome and history can be given by a guide to your guests as they are seated in the garden.
