Cass County Board of Supervisors

Tuesday, November 22, 2022

The Cass County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the board room at the courthouse with members present: Steve Baier chair; Stephen Green, John Hartkopf, Mark O'Brien (by Zoom) and Bernard Pettinger. Absent: none.

Baier called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

Green moved, Pettinger seconded, to adopt the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Hartkopf moved, Green seconded to approve the November 15, 2022 regular meeting minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

Green moved, Hartkopf seconded to approve the November 18, 2022 special meeting minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

At 9:07 a.m., Baier recessed for a Public Hearing on Proposed Amendment to Zoning, changing McCunn Specialty Firearms, LLC from Business District to Light Industrial District. There were no public comments. Green moved, Hartkopf seconded, to close the public hearing. All ayes. Motion carried. At 9:08 a.m., Baier closed the public hearing.

Wendy Mueller, Executive Director of West Central Community Action, gave the annual report.

County Engineer Trent Wolken gave his weekly report on the status of bridge projects and equipment in the county.

Action on Resolution No. 2022-054 to approve bids for projects BROS-C015(68)--8J-15 and BROS-SWAP-C015(74)--SE-15 was tabled until the November 30, 2022 meeting.

Green moved, Hartkopf seconded, approval of Resolution No. 2022-053 Authorization Approving Additional Allocation of ARPA Funds for a Retention Stipend in the amount of \$3,763.15. Ayes: Baier, Pettinger, Green, Hartkopf, O'Brien. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Green moved, Pettinger seconded, approval/disapproval of family farm credits and to approve agricultural land credits as recommended by the Assessor and the Auditor in accord with Code of Iowa (Chapters 425A & 426) for taxes collectible FY2022-23. Carried unanimously.

Committee reports:

Green reported the landfill is doing interviews for a staff member. Baier reported juvenile detention started on their budget. Pettinger reported on Zion Recovery Services. Harkopf reported an ag business is planning to come to Cass County.

Filed reports included: Post-Election Audit.
