## Resolution No. 2024-12 Vacate a County Road Easement, Portion of Lyman Street Cass County

and

Lyman Street right of way in the SE1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 9-74-36 and shown as Lyman Street R.O.W. on a plat of survey recorded in Book 5, Page 601 in the Cass County Recorder's Office,

and

Lyman Street right of way in the NW1/4 of the SW1/4 of Section 10-74-36,

and

Lyman Street right of way in the south 213.93 feet of the SW1/4 of the NW1/4 of Section 9-74-36.

WHEREAS, no objections have been received, either in writing or by persons present,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Cass County Board of Supervisors that the subject section of road be ordered vacated and closed.
