The Primary Election will be held in Cass County, IA on Tuesday, June 2, 2026. Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.

Election Day Voting

Pre-registered voters must provide an approved form of identification at the polling place to receive and cast a ballot. Approved forms of identification include Iowa driver's license or non-operator identification card, U.S. Passport, U.S. military or veteran's identification, tribal identification/document, or an Iowa voter identification card with PIN number.

Voters who are not pre-registered, such as those registering on Election Day or changing precincts, must provide proof of identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents. If a voter cannot provide these, they may:

- Have a registered voter from their precinct attest to their identity and residence, or
- Cast a provisional ballot and bring the required proof of identity and residence to the Cass County Auditor's Office by 12:00 p.m. on June 4, 2026.

Absentee Voting

- In-person-absentee voting will be available at the Cass County auditor's office:
 - 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Wednesday, May 13th - Monday, June 1, 2026
 - 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday, May 18th & Friday, May 29, 2026
 - 7:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Saturday, May 30, 2026
- Those wishing to vote by mail may submit an absentee ballot request form to the county auditor's office by Monday, May 18, 2026 at 5:00 p.m.
 - Absentee ballot request forms are available at sos.iowa.gov/elections/electioninfo/absenteeinfo.html or by contacting the county auditor's office.
 - Absentee ballots must be returned to the county auditor's office by 8:00 p.m. on election night.
- Absentee and special-voter ballots will be counted at the county auditor's office on Election Day.

Accessibility
