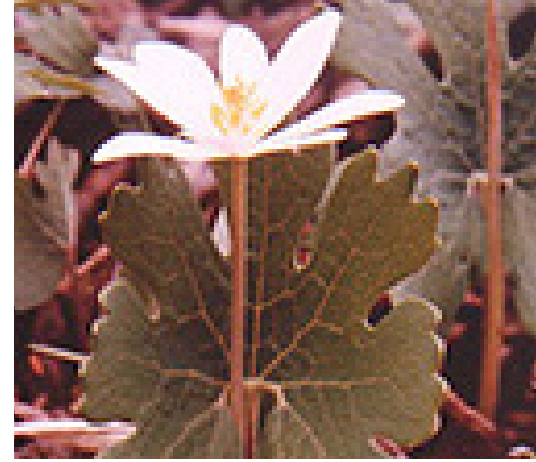
Pre-K teachers NO programs this month, and May is filling up fast!
