Green moved, O'Brien second, too approve Resolution 2023-40 Allocating APR funds to the Hitchcock House for foundation repairs in the amount of the final bill, which was \$47,932. Ayes: Green, Richter, O'Brien, Baier, Pettinger. Nays: none. Motion carried.

Pettinger moved, O'Brien second, to appoint Lorilyn Schultes to the Cass County Board of Health for the three-year term from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2027. All ayes. Motion carried.

Committee reports: O'Brien reported a few replacement parts for courthouse windows have arrived and will be installed soon.
