The Cass County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 a.m. in the board room at the courthouse with members present: Steve Baier, chair; Stephen Green, Wendy Richter, Mark O'Brien and Bernard Pettinger. Absent: none.

Pettinger moved, O'Brien second, to adopt the agenda. All ayes. Motion carried.

Richter moved, Pettinger second, to approve the May 2, 2023 minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

Tracee Knapp, introduced herself as Congressman Zach Nunn's Constituent Services Representative based in Creston, IA.

O'Brien moved, Green second, approval of Resolution No. 2023-16, Establishing the 2023 Cass County Noxious Weed Control Program. Ayes: Baier, Pettinger, Green, Richter, O'Brien. Nays: None. Motion carried.

Green moved, O'Brien second, approval of Resolution No. 2023-17, Setting the Date for Public Hearing on the Sale of Real Estate in Cass County, Iowa for May 16, 2023 at 9:00 AM. Ayes: Baier, Pettinger, Green, O'Brien. Nays: Richter. Motion carried. The resolution pertained closing the sale of the County Farm that was auctioned on January 21, 2023 to Milk Unlimited Dairy Farms, L.P. for \$1,762,946.

Green moved, Pettinger second, to appoint Terry Duggan to the Veterans Affairs Commission, term expiring June 30, 2026.
