A welcoming spot to rest is a beautiful butterfly garden



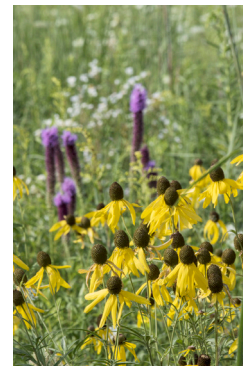
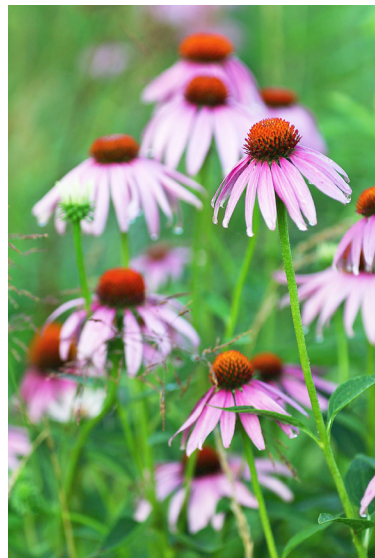
All types and sizes of wildlife to be watched and enjoyed
