WHEREAS, Cass County applied for, and has received, the first and second transfer of funds for the American Rescue Plan Act totaling \$2,493,243.00; and

WHEREAS, based on the distribution guidelines from the US Department of Treasury, the following project, not to exceed \$10,000.00, has been approved for the use of said funds:

Install handicap access to the CAM Middle School Library to provide a safe and secure area for a polling place for elections within the school building. Scope of work is to be a new handicap access door and concrete ramp into entrance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Cass County Board of Supervisors endorses the disbursement of American Rescue Plan Act Funds for the item listed, and authorizes the Auditor to make payment as presented.
