

• Live plants from nursery will come as small plugs; cells are 5" deep x 2" wide at top or 4.5"deep x 2" Cone.

• Immediate care: remove plants from container as soon as possible and water thoroughly.

• Plant in the ground or a larger pot.

• Keep area around plants weed free, especially during the first growing season.

• Watering is important during the first growing season. Make sure the plants do not go dry for the first 3-6 weeks; water deeply to allow formation of deep drought and frost resistant roots. Once

established, native plants can withstand extreme weather.
