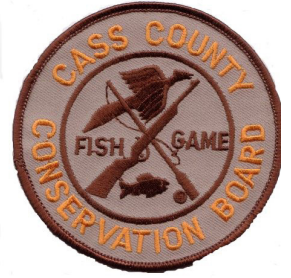

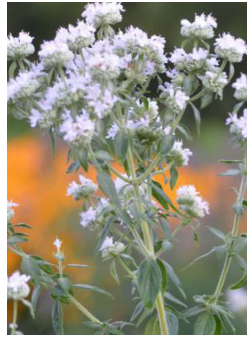

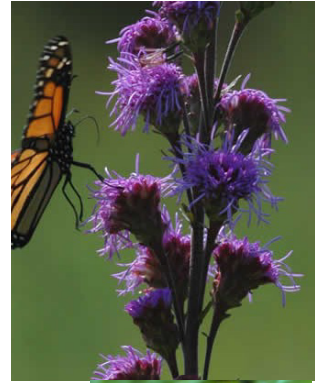
Prairie Dropseed *Sporobolus heterolepis*  
 Light: Full Sun  
 Soil: Sand, Loam  
 Moisture: Dry, Medium  
 Benefits: Birds, Deer Resistant  
 Height: 2'-4'  
 Blooms: Aug, Sep  
 Color: Straw-Gold

Hairy Mountain Mint  
*Pycnanthemum verticillatum*  
 var. *pilosum*  
 Sun Exposure Full sun to part shade  
 Soil Moisture Medium  
 Height 3 feet  
 Bloom Time July, Aug  
 Color White



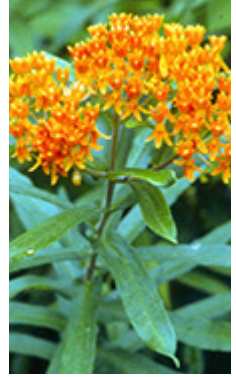
Prairie/Stiff Coreopsis *Coreopsis palmata*  
 Light: Full Sun  
 Soil: Tolerant to poor soils  
 Moisture: Dry to Medium  
 Benefits: Bees, deer resistant, Birds  
 Height: 2'  
 Blooms: Jun, July, Aug  
 Color: Yellow

Meadow Blazing Star  
*Liatris ligulistylis*  
 Sun Exposure Full sun to part shade  
 Soil Moisture Medium  
 Height 5 feet  
 Bloom Time Aug—Sept  
 Color Purple



Sneezeweed *Helenium autumnale*  
 Light: Full Sun, Partial  
 Soil: Moist, well drained  
 Moisture: Wet to medium-wet  
 Benefits: Rain gardens, Pollinators, Birds  
 Height: 4'  
 Blooms: Aug, Sept, Oct  
 Color: Yellow

Butterfly Milkweed  
*Asclepias tuberosa*  
 Plant Spacing 1-3'  
 Sun Exposure Full sun or part shade  
 Soil Moisture Medium to Dry, well- drained  
 Height 2 feet  
 Bloom Time June—August



Purple Prairie Clover *Dalea Purpurea*  
 Light: Full Sun  
 Soil: Sand, Loam, Clay  
 Moisture: Dry, Medium  
 Benefits: Pollinators, birds, Host plant  
 Height: 1'-2'  
 Blooms: Jul, Aug,  
 Color: Purple

New England Aster  
*Aster Novae-angliae*  
 Light: Full Sun- partial  
 Soil: Sand, Loam, Clay  
 Moisture: Medium  
 Benefits: Pollinators, Butterflies, Birds, Deer Resistant  
 Height: 3'-6'  
 Blooms: Aug, Sept, Oct  
 Color: Purple



Swamp Milkweed  
*Asclepias incarnata*  
 Sun Exposure Full sun or part shade  
 Soil Moisture Wet to Medium  
 Bloom Time June—August  
 Color Pink Height 4 feet

## **Live Plants**

- Live plants from nursery will come as small plugs; cells are 5" deep x 2" wide at top or 4.5" deep x 2" Cone.
- Immediate care: remove plants from container as soon as possible and water thoroughly.
- Plant in the ground or a larger pot.
- Keep area around plants weed free, especially during the first growing season.
- Watering is important during the first growing season. Make sure the plants do not

go dry for the first 3-6 weeks; water deeply to allow formation of deep drought and frost resistant roots. Once established, native plants can withstand extreme weather.
