
Tuesday, February 18, 2020



Carol Dorsey told the board she had safety concerns regarding roadways north of Anita. Concerns included: some building sites do not have address signs; and some roadways now have increased traffic which includes large trucks and some of the roadways are not wide, some have narrow shoulders, and some are not paved. Another concern was spraying of ditches. Supervisor Baier stated the spraying she described was probably being done by a utility company and not by the County. All items taken under advisement.

Code of Iowa has was amended last year and an additional public hearing is needed before adopting the FY2021 budget.

Motion by Green, 2nd by Hartkopf: to set March 3 as the date for a public hearing to pass a resolution setting the maximum property tax dollars that may be levied for the General County Services and Rural County Services funds for FY2021. Carried unanimously.

The mayor of Lewis has appointed members to the city library board and the appointment of the non-city resident trustee, per city ordinance, needs to be approved by the county board of supervisors.

Motion by O'Brien, 2nd by Green: to approve the appointment of Nadine King as the nonresident member to the Lewis Public Library board of trustees. Carried unanimously.

Motion by O'Brien, 2nd by Hartkopf: to approve the application for a Class C Liquor License with Outdoor Sales and Sunday Sales privilege of Griswold Golf and Country Club (67777 560th St.). Carried unanimously.

Motion by Green, 2nd by Hartkopf: to authorize Frank Waters to the sign the new 28E to be part of the Southwest Iowa Mental Health and Disability Service (MHDS) Region on behalf of Cass County. Carried unanimously.

Two persons are resigning from membership, and two are applying for membership on the Cass County Food Policy Council.

Motion by O'Brien, 2nd by Green: to approve the resignations of DeeAnn Schreiner and Jan Steffen; and to appoint Natalie Ritter as a member and LaVon Eblen as an associate member of the Cass County Food Policy Council (terms ending 12/31/2022). Carried unanimously.
