DESIGNATE THROUGH ROADS AND ERECT STOP SIGN

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236, 321.237, and 321.255 to designate through roads and cause to be erected regulatory signs in accordance with standards established by the lowa Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, with a recent increase in traffic on Lansing Road in combination with insufficient sight distance at the T-intersection of Lansing Road and 595th Street, near the North ½ Corner of S36-T78N-R37W (Washington Twp.), it was deemed necessary to designate westbound traffic on Lansing Road as a stop approach; and

WHEREAS, northbound traffic on 595th Street would remain a stop approach; and

WHEREAS, eastbound traffic on Lansing Road would remain a through approach;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Cass County Supervisors that a stop sign be erected on the northeast corner of the intersection to stop westbound traffic on Lansing Road
