Director's Report: Mike Kennon said that big projects in the last year have greatly depleted the 911SB fund balance. These projects were very worthy and necessary, but we may need to conserve funds before we can consider other projects.

Motorola has recently sent a proposal for an Enhancement Site on the Atlantic Water Tower. This would be a very substantial project, more than the 911SB Board could ever consider. The Board would likely be asked to support the proposal and promote the effort to County stakeholders and to the general public.

New Business: Kennon has been in contact with IDOT concerning putting equipment on a tower site south of Atlantic. When Kennon gets more details on options available, he will bring these options to the Board.
